**1 // Fairbanks, AK** Our adventure to scenic Alaska begins with a **flight** to Fairbanks today.

**2 // Fairbanks, AK** This morning, take the **Riverboat Discovery** for a cruise into the heart of Alaska through the eyes of a family celebrating four generations of history on the river. A hearty **lunch** is included. For dinner, enjoy the freshest seafood Alaska has to offer at **Alaska Salmon Bake**, one of the oldest single family owned restaurants in Fairbanks.

**3 // Denali National Park, AK** Board the **Alaska Railway** for a breathtaking excursion further into Alaska's interior. Spend the first of two nights at a lodge located on the outskirts of Denali National Park. Enjoy a dinner with a side of laughter at **Denali's Cabin Nite Dinner Theatre**.

**4 // Denali National Park, AK** Experience spectacular Alaskan beauty and adventure as we travel into **Denali National Park** on a narrated half-day trip. We'll be able to see a grand view of North America's tallest peak, unspoiled landscape and wildlife. A **Box Lunch** is included today. Later, enjoy dinner with the group.

**5 // Anchorage, AK** Begin your morning with an authentic look into the rural Alaskan lifestyle at the **Husky Homestead** and experience the Alaskan Husky in a whole new way. Hear stories from the trail and see actual racing sleds from Alaska's Interior. Stop in the charming mountain town of Talkeetha and enjoy the gift shops, art galleries & local scenery.

**6 // Anchorage, AK** Hop on board a narrated **Trolley Tour** of downtown Anchorage this morning. Learn about the history, culture and modern life as

we pass by significant sites. Then, we'll visit **The ULU Factory**. This unique knife, leftover from the ancient Eskimo culture, is one of Alaska's most noteworthy items. After **lunch**, gain an appreciation for the fascinating local culture with a visit to the **Alaska Native Heritage Center**. Discover how people survived the harsh climate with ingenuity and cooperation for over one-thousand years.

**7 // Seward, AK** This morning, board an **Aerial Tram** and enjoy a breathtaking view of Turnagain Arm, hanging glaciers and endless snow-capped peaks from the top of **Mt. Alyeska**. Enjoy lunch with a view and then board **Royal Caribbean's Radiance of the Seas** cruise ship. For the next seven nights, delicious dining experiences, world-class amenities and activities are available on board.

**8 // Hubbard Glacier, AK** Cruise past **Hubbard Glacier** this morning and notice the deep blue color of the glacier face. Unlike nearly every tidewater glacier on the continent, Hubbard is advancing, not retreating; it's forever pushing a little further into the bay.

**9 // Juneau, AK** Surrounded by water, forest and mountains, **Juneau** is the most remote and arguably the most unique state capital in the nation.

**10 // Skagway, AK** The gateway to the gold rush, **Skagway's** history is fascinating and brutal. The small downtown is the hub for many optional excursions that can bring you deeper into the culture and climate of early settlers.

**11 // Icy Strait Point, AK** Simple villages dot the entire Alaska coastline. **Icy Strait Point** is home to a salmon cannery that is open for tours to help us learn about this way of life.

**12 // Ketchikan, AK** Ketchikan is the gateway to the wild landscapes and seascapes of **Misty Fjords National Monument**. It is home to three tribes of Northwest Coast Indians, making it a great place to get a taste for the local culture. You'll see it in the colorful, hand-carved totems that line the city's streets and parks, and in the unique stilted homes that cling to Deer Mountain's slopes.

**13 // At Sea** Sailing though Alaska's **Inside Passage** offers opportunities to see whales, otters, eagles and other wildlife against the backdrop of forests and fjords. Peaceful waters make this a great place to relax.

**14 // Home** Disembark in **Vancouver** today and fly home having sampled the Best of Alaska, by land, rail and sea.
