

SPECTACULAR ALASKA

Embark on a spectacular tour to Alaska. Discover the wildlife native to Alaska, explore mighty glaciers in Valdez, and soak up the rich history of the gold rush. Of course, no trip to Alaska is complete without a visit to Denali, home to North America's tallest peak.

Day 1 // Anchorage, AK The adventure begins with a flight to Anchorage. As the state's largest city, Anchorage encompasses natural wonders and metropolitan appeal.

Day 2 // Denali National Park, AK Begin the day learning about Alaska native culture and traditions with a visit to Alaska Native Heritage Center. Stop to explore the charming pioneer town of Talkeetna where the historic downtown features art galleries, boutiques and true Alaska charm. Towering mountain ranges, glacial river valleys, waterfalls and natural beauty will keep your cameras busy as we arrive in Denali for the first of a 2-night stay. Indulge in a delicious group dinner tonight.

Day 3 // Denali National Park, AK Experience spectacular Alaskan beauty and adventure as we visit Denali National Park on a narrated half-day trip. Capture a grand view of North America's tallest peak, unspoiled landscape and wildlife. A scenic stretch of snow-capped mountains and verdant green valley give us plenty of picture opportunities, and our relaxed pace leaves time to breathe in that crisp, clean air. A box lunch is included. This evening, enjoy a dinner with a side of laughter at Denali's Cabin Nite Dinner Theatre.

Day 4 // Fairbanks, AK Our adventure leads us to Fairbanks on a beautiful route winding along the Tanana River, and we travel through charming towns that reached their heyday during the Gold Rush. Strike it rich in the gold fields of Alaska on a tour that will take you into the heart of the gold fields of the Tanana Valley at the Gold Dredge 8. You will be guided through the entire dredge as you see, touch and learn about the history that it contains and the dredge's importance to the development of Fairbanks. For dinner, enjoy the freshest seafood Alaska has to offer at Alaska Salmon Bake, one of the oldest

single family owned restaurants in Fairbanks.

Day 5 // Fairbanks, AK This morning, take the Riverboat Discovery for a cruise into the heart of Alaska through the eyes of a family celebrating four generations of history on the river. Watch one of Alaska's bush pilots take off right from the River and learn about the rich native heritage at our unforgettable stop at the Chena Indian Village. After lunch, bundle up for a visit to the Ice Museum which showcases the unique talents of ice sculptures, as we watch them transform blocks of ice into intricate pieces of art.

Day 6 // Valdez, AK The route from Fairbanks to Valdez offers some of the most classic views of the Last Frontier. On our way, make a memorable stop in North Pole, Alaska and immerse yourself in the world famous Santa Claus House. Find a perfect gift or keepsake for friends and family.

Day 7 // Valdez, AK Cruise the majestic waters of Prince William Sound on a journey to Columbia Glacier. View history in the making as Columbia Glacier retreats back into the Chugach Mountains. In addition to the amazing ice in Columbia Bay, catch a glimpse of wildlife along the way, and learn about the mining, oil shipping, earthquake and fishing history of the area. A light lunch is served on board.

Day 8 // Anchorage, AK Explore the Independence Mine State Park, the resting place of an abandoned gold mine that is a testament to Alaska's rich Gold Rush history.

Day 9 // Seward, AK All aboard the iconic Alaska Railroad for an early morning departure. The popular Coastal Classic route winds along Turnagain Arm and through the backcountry wilderness of the Kenai Peninsula. Spectacular views of massive glaciers and towering waterfalls can be captured from our seats in the glass-dome rail cars. Upon reaching Seward, the train comes to a halt on the shores of Resurrection Bay. Seward is known as "Mile 0" on the Iditarod Trail, and this afternoon we'll visit a local homestead and sled dog kennel to learn more about the most demanding race on earth and cuddle some adorable husky pups.



Board an Aerial Tram and enjoy a breathtaking view of Turnagain Arm, hanging glaciers and endless snow-capped peaks from the top of Mt. Alyeska. While here, enjoy lunch with a view. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner tonight, sharing memories from an unforgettable vacation.

Day 12 // Overnight Flight Hop on board a narrated Trolley Tour of downtown Anchorage. Learn about the history, culture and modern life as we pass by significant sites. Stop by the Ulu Factory to learn about the traditional knife adapted from ancient Eskimo craftsmen and one of Alaska's most noteworthy items. Spend some time shopping for souvenirs at the Wild Berry Farm. Here, you'll find chocolates, wild berry jams and jellies and smoked salmon baskets and gifts. Feast on a hearty lunch before heading to the airport for our overnight flight home.

Day 13 // Home Say farewell to the last frontier as we arrive home with cherished memories from our tour of Spectacular Alaska.
